Location

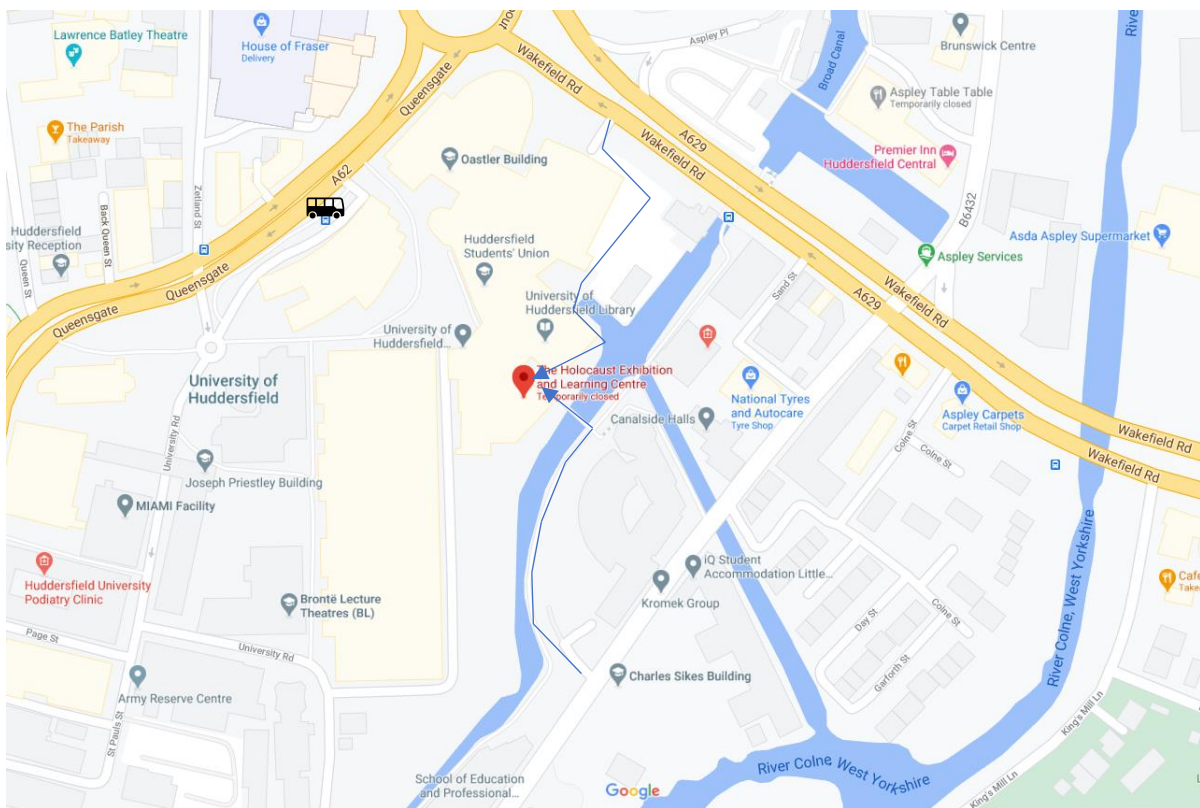
We are located on Level 2 of the Schwann Building at the University of Huddersfield. For more information please see the campus map

You can reach the Centre entrance on foot from Wakefield Road or Firth Road (see below map with walking routes marked in blue). For safety reasons we are asking groups not to walk through other University buildings en route to us, unless your group needs level access.



Parking

Unfortunately we cannot provide coach parking on campus. We recommend that coaches drop pupils in the bus stop lay-by on Queensgate next to the Richard Steinitz building (marked by the bus icon on the above map and 31 on the campus map). There is space here to drop passengers off safely and you can walk round to the Wakefield Road route. The coach will then need to park off site. The University's Schools and College Liaison recommend the John Smith's Stadium however this is at the coach company's discretion.

For minibuses we recommend that you drop students off at the same place. We can sometimes arrange minibus parking on campus, however spaces are limited and need to be pre-booked with the learning team. Please let us know at the time of your booking if you would like to request parking, or need a closer drop-off place due to access needs. When

parking is not available on site it is the school's responsibility to make parking arrangements.

Lunch

We do not have a dedicated lunch space at the Holocaust Exhibition & Learning Centre, and for safety reasons it is not currently possible for your group to eat elsewhere on the University campus. We advise that you have lunch in school before or after your booking.

Accessibility at the Centre

We have a disabled access route to the exhibition via a lift located on Level 4 of the Schwann Building near the Library. Please let us know in advance if any of your group needs level access and need to come through the Schwann Building to reach us.
